Empathic Behaviour Management



Are you struggling with poor behaviour from your cared for child? Tried everything and nothing works?

Empathic Behaviour Management is different from the usual reward and consequences used by most parents. Instead, it looks at how reconnecting with your child can bring about a better relationship and, in turn, improved behaviours.

Building Bonds and Breaking Cycles



Required course for ALL carers.

As Foster carers, you are often parenting and caring for children who have suffered trauma, separation, and loss. When children act out their anxiety and experiences of loss/separation it is highly likely to trigger your own childhood experiences and personal issues.

In this course, Dr Lisa Marsland Hall, founder of Sefton BABs, will discuss what adverse childhood experiences are and the impact they can have on our inner working models; the patterns of attachment we may see in our children and recognise in ourselves; and the importance of head space so we can hold our children in mind.


