TRAINING NEWS

Safer Care and Allegation is now a mandatory course

(needs to be attended by both carers every three years)

Children who are displaying vulnerabilities need adaptation to their care and your safer care plan should reflect this. The impact of allegations in fostering homes is so profound as a service we need to be proactive to protect all concerned. If you have not updated your Safer carer and allegation course in the last three years you will both need to complete it.

Change to Level Two courses

Children's Rights and Advocacy (new course added)

Parenting a child who has been sexually abused now an optional course

Skills scheme

Both Level One and Level Two courses need to be attended through Sefton Fostering Services in house offer, to ensure that the key messages are delivered and to introduce you to the staff and carers who can support your journey.

Workbooks

All foster carers in England and Wales need to complete the Workbook for the Training Support and Development Standards. Carers need to complete them within 12 months for Mainstream families and 18 months for kinship families.

Monthly workshops have been arranged to support anyone who has not yet completed them.
